An indicator is added to the solution being titrated. The indicator is a substance that changes color when the reaction is complete. Phenolphthalein, which is a commonly used acid-base indicator, is added to the acid solution in a flask. Phenolphthalein has two chemical forms. In acidic conditions it is colorless. In basic conditions it turns red.
